Who we are

We are the only residential adult further education college in the Midlands, delivering life-changing learning, situated in Selly Oak, Birmingham, close to the city centre. Based in a manor house that once belonged to George Cadbury Jnr., surrounded by 6 acres of grounds, we are an ideal place for people to relax and unwind, learn new things and focus on themselves. The college is a vibrant place welcoming students onto a range of 3 day courses and longer residential courses from Entry Level 3 to Level 5. Courses include personal and social development, social justice themed courses, outdoor learning, functional skills and skills for work both for those seeking employment and working professionals.

Funded largely by the West Midlands Combined Authority, our students live in the West Midlands county including Birmingham, Wolverhampton, Walsall, Dudley, Sandwell, Solihull and Coventry and are often eligible for fully funded or subsidised courses.

How we work with our referral partners

We engage with our referral partners in a number of ways:

Open days:
